Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section
- 2 28-1212.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
- 3 provisions relating to possession of a stolen firearm; and to repeal
- 4 the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. Section 28-1212.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,  
2 is amended to read:

3           28-1212.03   (1) Any person who possesses, receives, retains, or  
4 disposes of a stolen firearm knowing that it has been or believing that  
5 it has been stolen shall be guilty of a Class IIA felony unless the  
6 firearm is possessed, received, retained, or disposed of with intent to  
7 restore it to the owner.

8           (2) Any person who possesses, receives, retains, or disposes of a  
9 stolen firearm when such person should have known, or had reasonable  
10 cause to believe, that such firearm has been stolen shall be guilty of a  
11 Class IIA felony unless the firearm is possessed, received, retained, or  
12 disposed of with intent to restore it to the owner.

13           Sec. 2. Original section 28-1212.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
14 Nebraska, is repealed.
