Mr. FROST introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to improve firearm destruction practices, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Destroy Zombie Guns
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. SAFE FIREARM DESTRUCTION.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 922 of title 18, United
8 States Code is amended by adding at the end the fol-
9 lowing:

1 “(aa) It shall be unlawful for any person engaged in
2 the business of destroying firearms, while destroying or
3 aiding in the destruction of a firearm that has been
4 shipped or transported in interstate or foreign commerce,
5 to not destroy every component of the firearm.”.

6 (b) DEFINITION OF “ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS”
7 AS APPLIED TO A DESTROYER OF FIREARMS.—Section
8 921(a)(21) of such title is amended—

9 (1) by striking “and” at the end of subpara-
10 graph (E);

11 (2) by striking the period at the end of para-
12 graph (F) and inserting “; and”; and

13 (3) by adding at the end the following:

14 “(G) as applied to a destroyer of firearms, a
15 person who devotes time, attention, and labor to the
16 destruction of firearms or firearm components as a
17 regular course of trade or business to predominantly
18 earn a profit through services rendered to facilitate
19 the destruction of a firearm or firearm compo-
20 nents.”.

21 (c) PENALTIES.—Section 924(a) of such title is
22 amended by adding at the end the following:

23 “(9)(A) Any person who violates section 922(aa) shall
24 be fined under this title, imprisoned for not more than

1 2 years, or both, in addition to any penalty imposed on
2 the person under paragraph (2) of this subsection.

3 “(B) In addition to any penalty imposed under sub-
4 paragraph (A) of this paragraph on a licensee under this
5 chapter, the Attorney General may, after notice and op-
6 portunity for a hearing, suspend the license issued to the
7 licensee in the case of the first violation of section 922(aa),
8 or, in the case of any subsequent violation, shall imme-
9 diately revoke the license.”.

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
